Acknowledgement Form

Being a student-athlete at the University of Prince Edward Island is a privilege and my personal conduct reflects upon the sport I play, my teammates, opponents, coaches, university supporters and myself. To be a student-athlete at the University of Prince Edward Island is to accept and adopt the concepts of fair play, respect, dignity, enjoyment and honour in all aspects of my sport participation.

I will conduct myself in a manner in which my behaviour will not be considered a form of harassment, including comments and/or conduct which is insulting, intimidating, hurtful, malicious, degrading or otherwise offensive to an individual or group of individuals. As such, I agree to respect my fellow teammates by adhering to and upholding principles of not engaging in any form of hazing or any form of sexist, racist or discriminatory language and/or behaviour.

As a student-athlete, I am a representative of the University of Prince Edward Island; and as such, I am expected to conduct myself at all times in an appropriate manner. Poor conduct and other such inappropriate behaviour reflects negatively on the University of Prince Edward Island and the Athletic program.

I will refrain from the use of alcohol or illegal drugs during competition, during practice, in university team and/or dressing rooms, in accommodations provided for my team on overnight trips, and while traveling to and from competition. At all other times, I will ensure the responsible use of alcohol and refrain from the use of illegal drugs.

I am aware that the University of Prince Edward Island Athletic program has zero tolerance towards abuse of officials; and as an athlete, it is my responsibility to respect officials at all events, tournaments and games.

In addition, I am responsible for ensuring my behaviour and deportment are above reproach when occupying accommodations while representing the University of Prince Edward Island. I am aware that I am personally responsible for any damages or charges that are assessed to the room in which I have been assigned.

I am also aware that the University of Prince Edward Island is unequivocally opposed to the use of any banned or restricted substances or methods of contravention of the rules of Canadian Interuniversity Sport, national or international sport federations, the International Olympic Committee or International Federation of University Sport. As a student-athlete, I am also aware that the University of Prince Edward Island is equally opposed to any encouragement of the use of such substances and methods by individuals in positions of leadership in amateur sport (ie: coaches, managers, medical practitioners, sport scientists, administrators, etc.) or by other student-athletes themselves.

Finally, I am aware that as a student-athlete at the University of Prince Edward Island, failure to adhere to the University of Prince Edward Island Athlete's Code of Conduct may result in a hearing before the Director of Athletics and could result in the following taking place:

- Written warning
- Suspension from competition
- Suspension from the team

University of Prince Edward Island Athletic Program Code of Conduct

The University of Prince Edward Island Athletic Program requires that all personnel conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the high values and tradition maintained by UPEI.

The Head Coach of each interuniversity team is responsible to model, establish and implement rules and behavioural expectations. These rules and expectations must be consistent with academic and athletic excellence goals and enhance the reputation and image of the University of Prince Edward Island as long as the individual remains part of the interuniversity program. This applies both at competition and outside of competitions throughout the season.

The University of Prince Edward Island Athletic Program is committed to the following behavioural expectations for all team personnel, support personnel and student-athletes at all times:

- Your behaviour enhances the image of the University of Prince Edward Island
- You conduct yourself in the spirit of sporting behaviour and fair play in all situations
- You will not take part in any public misconduct
 - Elimination of hazing of any type*
**Hazing means any intentional, knowing or reckless act committed by a student, whether individually or in concert with other persons, against another student and in which both of the following apply:*
 - a) *The act was committed in connection with an initiation into, an affiliation with or the maintenance of membership in any organization that is affiliated with an education institute.*
 - b) *The act contributes to a substantial risk or potential injury, mental harm or degradation or causes physical injury, mental harm or personal degradation.*
 - Elimination of sexist, racial or discriminatory language and/or behaviour
- You will not wilfully damage the property of others which would include, but not be limited to, the following:
 - Hotel rooms
 - Other university campuses
 - Transportation vehicles
- You will conform to provincial and federal laws as well as the regulations of the University of Prince Edward Island
- You will refrain from the use of illegal substances at all times and will only use alcohol in a responsible manner.
- You will refrain from the use of illegal substances at all times and will only use alcohol in a responsible manner. Alcohol will not be permitted during competition, practice, in university team and/or dressing rooms, in accommodation provided by the university while on overnight trips, or while traveling to and from competition.

Incidents brought to the attention of the Office of the Director of Athletics will be investigated by the Director, in consultation with the Head Coach and the student-athlete(s) and/or personnel concerned. Disciplinary action, if any, may be appealed to the VP Finance & Facilities within 48 hours of the decision of the Director.
