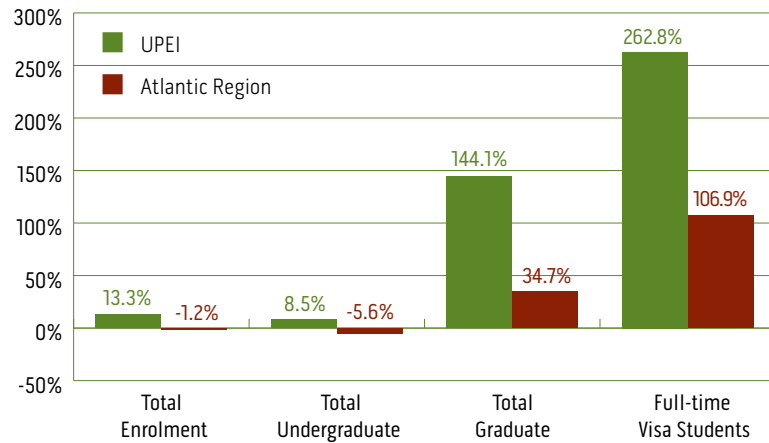

In 2013-2014, Atlantic universities collectively experienced a decline in undergraduate enrolment (for both full-time and part-time students), full-time first-entry students, and transfer students. The region saw growth in only graduate enrolment and international student categories. UPEI outperformed regional averages on both these fronts.

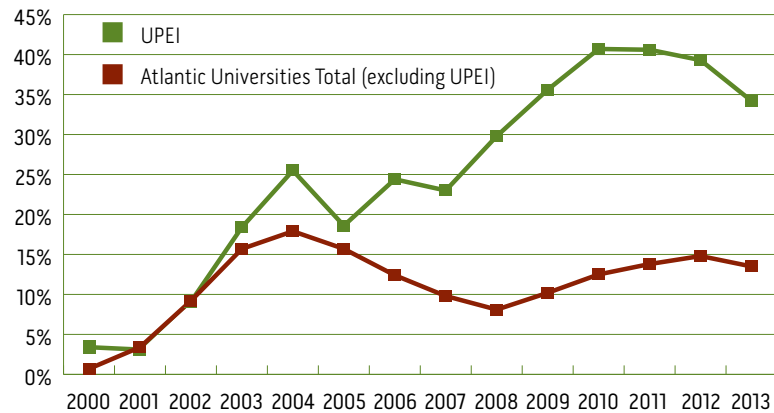
Over the past decade, Atlantic universities have collectively experienced a -1.2% decline in total enrolment. UPEI has outpaced the average regional rate with total enrolment growth of 13.3% for the same period.

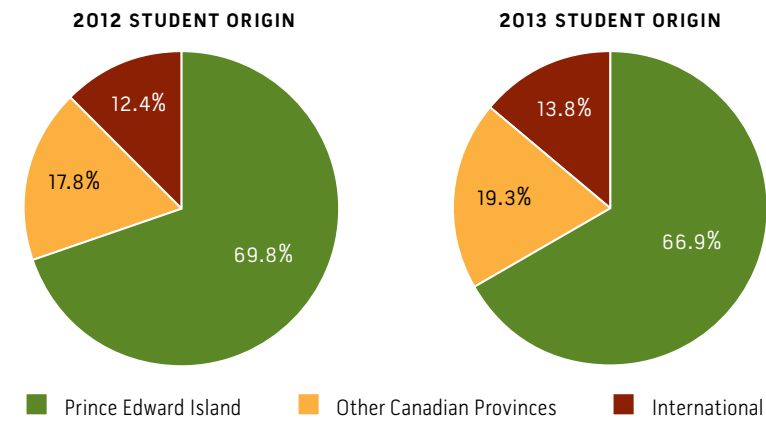

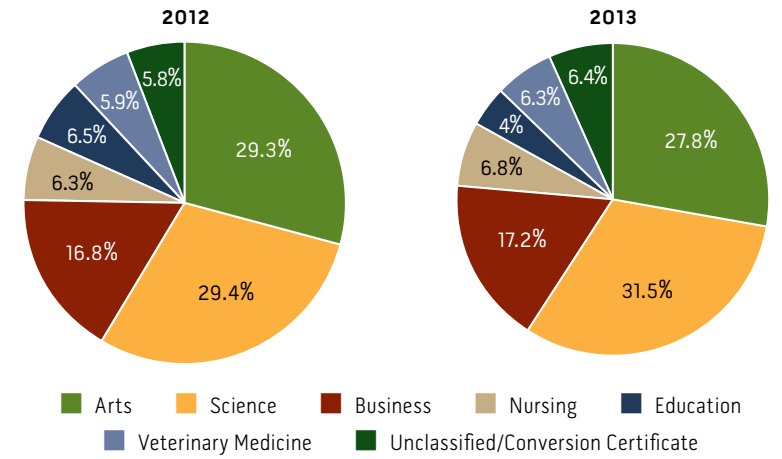
