**1 Purpose**

1.1 This policy is intended to recognize the contribution of seniors to the classroom and to encourage participation of Prince Edward Island residents sixty years of age or older in University courses.

**2 Scope**

2.1 This policy applies to Prince Edward Island residents who are sixty years of age or older hereafter referred to as 'Centennial Scholars'. This policy replaces the previous Centennial Scholarship Program and is effective September 1, 2006.

**3 Responsibility**

3.1 Responsibility for maintenance and review of this policy rests with the Registrar and the Vice President Academic Development.

**4 Policy**

4.1 Centennial Scholars are entitled to receive **one undergraduate course** (3 credit hours, credit or audit) **per year** with no charge for tuition. **To obtain the waiver of tuition, Centennial Scholars must file a Centennial Scholar Tuition Waiver form with the Registrar's Office.** Normal student fees (MAPUS, Admin, Student Union, etc.) shall apply.

4.2 In addition, Centennial Scholars may apply for bursaries under the Seniors' Bursary Program. This replaces the earlier Centennial Scholarships Program. The Seniors' Bursary Program provides bursaries for up to two undergraduate courses per semester and is based on financial need. This bursary is available for undergraduate course tuition only and does not apply to graduates studies, short courses, summer institutes, self financing courses, books or other fees. A maximum of ten (10) course bursaries per semester will be available under this program.

4.3 Centennial Scholars have the same rights and privileges available to all students at the University. The normal rules, processes and procedures governing registration for courses shall apply including the requirement for a tuition deposit prior to registration.

## University of Prince Edward Island Centennial Scholar Tuition Waiver

Centennial Scholars are entitled to receive **one undergraduate course** (3 credit hours, credit or audit) **per year** with no charge for tuition. To obtain the free course credit, Centennial Scholars must be sixty (60) year of age or older and file a Centennial Scholar Tuition Waiver form with the Registrar's Office. Normal student fees (MAPUS, Admin, Student Union, etc.) shall apply.
