## 1 Policy

Robertson Library Breezeway:

The Robertson Library Breezeway is a public access corridor and, as such, is not bookable space for public events. To safeguard unencumbered access to the Library, The Pit, ITEC and other areas of the Robertson Library building, the Breezeway is to remain free of obstruction, such as displays, tables or booths, except as authorized by the University and then only with the following limitations. From time to time, the University (through the Comptroller or Vice-President, Finance and Facilities) may permit the Student Union or other internal University organizations to set up a single public information table (maximum size - 3' x 6'), provided this table is not used for commercial or partisan political purposes, and also providing that the table set-up is authorized by the Director of Physical Plant and Security Services.

Booking of space by political parties:

The University encourages political debate on campus. Political parties or organizations may book space on campus in any of the classrooms, lecture theatres or other rooms identified by the University as available for public events on campus, at the usual rental rates. Public corridors, hallways, and some designated gathering areas are not available for public events or displays.

Booking of space for commercial purposes:

The University reserves the right to restrict commercial access to the campus. Limited access may be permitted in conjunction with conferences or sporting events, on the express permission of the appropriate University official.
