Definition of Full-time students:

- 1) students in Arts, Business, Science, Nursing, Education, Master of Education, Honors conversion, or unclassified who take at least 9 semester hours.
- 2) all students in DVM and MBA program.
- 3) Students in Island Studies: for Spring 2008, FT are those who took at least 4 semester hours and were not in maintenance status; and for Spring 2009 FT are those who were admitted as full-time students.
- 4) students in Master of Science, PhD, Master of VetScience, PostGrad Diploma, Master of Arts, and Master of Arts AHS program who were admitted as full-time students.

4th year students in Education program are those in Human Resource Development Program.

How cross-listed courses are reported in the Course Registration Statistics:

In the Column "# Courses/sections offered" and for both 2009 and 2010, cross-listed courses are counted only once and it is counted in the teaching unit only. For # Registration and only for 2010, students registered in cross-listed courses are also counted towards registration in the teaching unit. For example, for Spring 2010, ED 422 is cross listed with F SC 242 with F SC as the teaching department. The course is counted only once and it is included in Faculty of Science. Students registered in both F SC 242 and ED 422 are counted in registrations with Faculty of Science. For # Registration for 2009 in this report, students registered in cross-listed courses are counted towards the course faculty they registered under. For example, in Spring 2009, ED 213 was cross-listed with FR 261 with Education as the teaching unit. Because of the lack of necessary information to count all registrations towards Education as of the particular date, students registered under ED 213 are counted in Education while students registered under FR 261 are counted in Arts. But the course only counted once with Education for # Courses/sections offered.

Courses/sections offered: For Spring 2010, it is as of the reporting date and include courses that has no student registered yet (with AVC as an exception. see below for more detail). For Spring 2009, it is as of the end of semester thus include courses that were added later in the semester and exclude courses that are cancelled. The same day/week comparable information is not available.

AVC Courses are scheduled differently in a different system. Thus the number of courses/sections offered by AVC are those with at least one student registered. As registration continues, it will appear that more courses/sections are added by AVC whereas in fact it is simply because students are registered in more courses.
