

## **Description of the pre-Institute Portal Training, August 17, 2010**

The Public Health Agency of Canada's Canadian Best Practices Portal (CBPP) is a virtual front door to community and population health interventions related to chronic disease prevention and health promotion. These interventions have been evaluated, shown to be successful, and have the potential to be adapted and replicated by practitioners working in similar fields. The Portal is intended to enhance public health decisions using the best available evidence. This orientation will provide participants with a general overview to the Portal (<http://cbpp-pcpe.phac-aspc.gc.ca>), including its development, format and content. The presentation will also review how interventions and resources are selected for the Portal and how to nominate your own "best" practices.
