The Bill and Denise Andrews Scholarships in Island Studies

DESCRIPTION

In 2005, Bill and Denise Andrew contributed \$1 million to the University of Prince Edward Island benefiting all faculties at UPEI. As part of this donation, an unrestricted gift of \$50,000 was designated to the UPEI Faculty of Arts Master of Arts in Island Studies (MAIS) program. The MAIS program decided to use the undesignated funding for scholarships to attract and retain master's students.

GENERAL CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged on the basis of their academic performance, merit and particularly on their average scores registered during their MAIS program. Successful applicants will be expected to submit a brief report for use in a media release to the MAIS Co-ordinator following the receipt of the award. This will acknowledge the *Bill and Denise Andrew Scholarship in Island Studies*. Moreover, the student will ensure that any publication, poster, thesis, or any other relevant output by the said student will appropriately publicize the Award.

Students are not eligible for these scholarships if they:

- are in receipt of any other scholarship in excess of \$2,000 at the time of application;
- are a full-time UPEI employee; and/or
- have not completed at least three of the core MAIS courses.

AWARD VALUE

One Gold Award of \$1,500 and one Silver Award of \$1,000 are granted annually to students studying in the MAIS program at UPEI.

(1) - A brief overview (maximum one page, single spacing) of your MA(Island Studies) thesis topic, with special reference to: (a) the main hypothesis and (b) the proposed research methodology/ies;

(2) An annotated breakdown (maximum one page) of any expenses projected in connection with the pursuit of your thesis. These can include: (a) expenses directly connected to your thesis fieldwork (such as stationery, gas, economy travel, computer incidentals, accommodation, subscriptions, book and other relevant purchases); and/or (b) expenses (such as conference fees, economy travel and accommodation) connected to the presentation of thesis related 'work in progress' at national or international conferences. (In the latter case, evidence of the acceptance of your conference paper or abstract is required)

(3) A transcript of your current student record in the MA (Island Studies) at UPEI. (A minimum of three courses successfully completed at the MA level is required.)
