Essential Academic Qualifications:

- Degree in other subjects or a wealth of experience, may also be acceptable
- Experience working in fundraising, including the preparation of funding applications for trusts, foundations or businesses, and government.

Essential Professional Background:

- Good verbal and written communication skills,
- Good interpersonal skills, and the ability to motivate people and organizations to support Cuso International work
- Systematic and thorough, with an eye for detail.
- Ability to manage and prioritize a varied workload, working under pressure to tight deadlines.
