Job Description

The successful candidate will work with children one-on-one and in small groups to teach English, French, and/or Math. Candidates who can teach more than one of these subjects are preferred. French, in particular, would be a great asset, though we encourage those without competency in French to apply as well. Students range in grade level from first grade to twelfth grade, and so candidates should be comfortable working with students of varying ages and abilities. Most of our students come from immigrant families, and English is typically their second language, so any ESL teaching experience would be considered an asset.

Starting pay is \$16 – \$18 per hour depending on qualifications. Hours are flexible. Typically, classes are scheduled on weekends and between 3:30 pm and 8:00 pm on weekdays. Usually new tutors start with relatively few classes per week, but if they demonstrate competency and generate interest among parents, their hours may be increased (upwards of 30 hours per week if desired).

Qualifications

- -Minimum of one year of post-secondary education completed
- -Must be able to pass a criminal record check with a vulnerable sector inquiry
- -Previous teaching experience, especially in ESL, would be an asset
- -French is an asset (Native-level fluency, though ideal, is not strictly necessary. French tutors should be strong enough in French to work with French immersion students at a junior high level.)
