- Coordinates, supervises, delegates and evaluates the delivery of care ensuring the needs of residents are met
- Mentors, coaches, supports and provides guidance to staff within their scope of practice
- Manages performance concerns on an individual basis, maintaining therapeutic relationships with all team members. Takes initiative to have performance leadership conversations with staff as appropriate
- Communicates performance concerns to the Director of Care
- Participates actively in meetings and attends assigned committees, as able and carries out assigned responsibilities
