 - Cover letter
 - Brief summary of your experience, highlighting any employment with us
 - Top three choices for unit and location
 - Professional resume
 - Three references: clinical instructor, preceptor and previous employer/volunteer leader Clinical Instructor
3. You will receive a link to a screening questionnaire to complete. This provides information that helps match your interests to opportunities.
4. You will receive a link to our Predictive Index Survey, a behavioural assessment that takes less than 10 minutes to complete.
5. Our dedicated Talent Acquisition Specialist for Graduate Nurses will arrange for you to meet with our interview team, which will consist of Nurse Managers that will recommend areas for employment.
